law, so why not make the process as pain free as possible? They even do Cumberland County E-Class inspections.

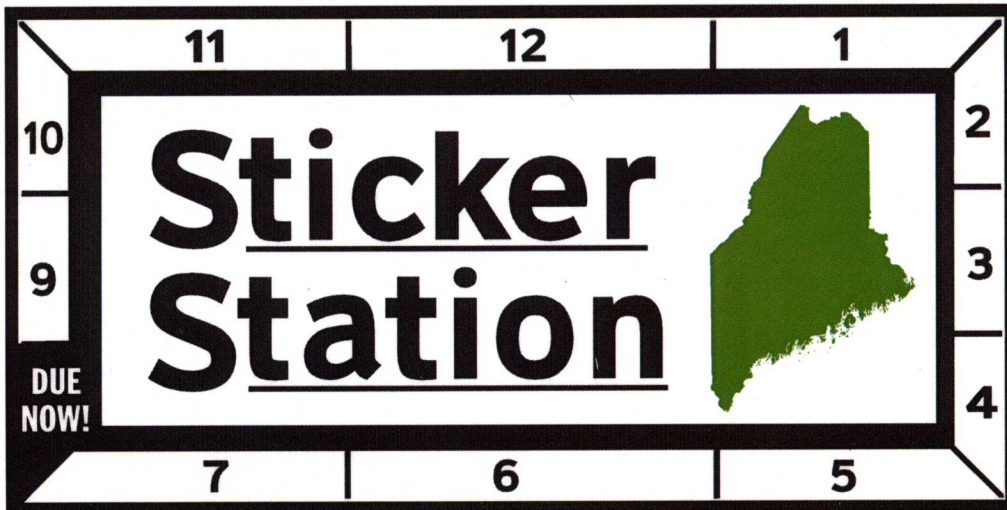
"If people need to drive around at the last minute and they have nowhere to go, they can come here," says Phil. "We're reliable and honest."
